

Dr Andrew Ebringer

As International SOS Medical Director, Dr Andrew Ebringer oversees the delivery of medical services, including occupational health, to major energy, mining and infrastructure client sites in the Australasian region. In this role Dr Ebringer also develops and coordinates control programs for malaria and other vector borne diseases and provides clinical governance leadership to site health staff.

For International SOS, Dr Ebringer has also worked as a Medical Advisor in Indonesia. In this role he performed site surveys and developed occupational health protocols and data systems on behalf of joint venture companies operating in Southeast Asia and supervised local medical and para-medical staff.

Prior to working at International SOS, Dr Ebringer was the Head of the Department of Clinical Studies and Surveillance at the Australian Army Malaria Institute, providing advice on prevention and treatment of tropical diseases such as malaria and dengue fever to the Australian Defence Force. He was also Principal Investigator on a number of clinical trials of new tropical disease vaccines and anti-malarials and has worked for many years as a Travel Medicine physician.

Previously, Dr Ebringer was a Public Health Physician and Medical Advisor at Townsville Division of GP as well as Senior Lecturer at James Cook University School of Medicine. In this role Dr Ebringer was tasked with expanding the health skills base within the primary health sphere and lectured to doctors and medical students on public health topics.

Dr Ebringer has also worked as the Director of Medical Services for Remote Health in the Northern Territory where he led a team of doctors who provided primary healthcare GP services and emergency medical retrievals with the RFDS to remote communities. During his time in the Northern Territory Dr Ebringer forged strong links between private enterprise, industry and non-government organisations to improve health care for indigenous Australians.

Dr Ebringer has written articles for a number of medical journals including *Human Vaccines*, *Malaria Journal* and *Vaccine*.
